When Ed Townsend and his wife discovered that their two-year old twin boy, Luke, had a severe stomach disorder that made him hypersensitive to foods and other things, they did all they could to make his life more comfortable. With the pronounced heat has come increases of algae in the pool. The Townsends are hoping that the longer they use the moss that they might get the same positive result other users have found in its effectiveness against algae, too: It can help control its proliferation, even in hot climates.

The best news though is Luke is learning to swim and not getting sick. "I was looking for a good alternative to high chlorine use," Luke's dad says. 'The less I have to use in the water, the better it is for our son and for the rest of the family, too".
