

Winter Moss™

Congratulations on your purchase of WinterMoss™! When the WinterMoss™ is put in your pool, it acts much like a tea bag. Material that will help keep your water stable and resist going bad will enter the water over time. It will remain in your water during the freeze and thaw cycle. After the ice thaws and before you open your pool, you will experience the benefits of having WinterMoss™ in your pool – better quality water and an easier start up in the spring requiring fewer chemicals to make your water swimmable!

Instructions for use:

Winter Season/Closing

- Remove the plastic bag protecting your WinterMoss™.
- Place WinterMoss™ directly into the pool water or in CC-STxS after partially draining for the winter months or after circulation pump is turned off for the season. If circulating water during the off season, secure submerged WinterMoss™ to a pool ladder or other fixture so it isn't drawn into the main drain.
- Cover pool for the season. (Optional)





Spring Season/Start Up

- Leave WinterMoss™ in the pool until pool opening.
- Using your leaf skimmer, pull the moss to a more shallow end of the pool and remove. (NOTE: the WinterMoss™ will weight approx. 8 pounds!). Remove **before** turning on the circulation pump for the pool so WinterMoss™ isn't drawn into the main drain.
- Refill pool (if drained) and balance pool water as normal (pH, alkalinity, calcium hardness, and EPA registered pool sanitizer).
- If using the PoolNaturally[®] system, refrain from using more than 30 ppm cyanuric acid, add PoolMoss[®] to the PoolStart[™] contact chamber (refer to product use instructions from PoolStart[™] kit or visit www.cwsnaturally.com). Enjoy your pool!

CC-STxS Maintenance and Operation

Startup of the CC-STxS

Open the contact chamber by moving the two individual bungees to the side of the lid at the corners. Caution: bungees are taut; take care not to pinch your fingers or hands.

- Break up the WinterMoss™
- Place bag of WinterMoss™ within the chamber.
- Close the lid to the contact chamber by placing the bungees back over the corners of the lid.
- Unscrew the U clamps on the nylon support rope and attach to the top edge of the contact chamber as shown in the image.
- Using the support rope slowly lower the contact chamber into the pool to a level such that it will always be submerged.
- Secure the carabineer to the top of the pool (e.g. the top railing of the stairs)
